

IDRIM Awards -- Call for Nominations

The International Society for Integrated Disaster Risk Management (IDRiM) annually presents awards to honor those who have distinguished themselves in three areas:

- Distinguished Research Award: To acknowledge members who have made significant contributions by providing path-breaking research to the discipline.
- Norio Okada Distinguished Implementation Science Award: To acknowledge someone who is not only active in research but also has done outstanding work on its implementation in the private, public and/or non-profit sectors.
- Aniello Amendola Distinguished Service Award: To acknowledge members who contributed significantly to the IDRiM Society by providing distinguished services.

Nominations are now open until August 20 for each of the three awards. It is preferable that the nominee be a member of IDRiM, though it is not necessary. Decisions will be announced by September 20, and Awards will be presented at the Annual Conference, September 21-23. Decisions will be made by the IDRiM Awards Committee

Nominations should contain the following (self-nominations are allowed):

- Nomination letter: Include the name, title, current affiliation and e-mail address of the nominee and the name of the Award for which the person is being considered.
- Nomination statement: Specific reasons for considering the nominee for the Award (maximum of 1,000 words)
- Curriculum Vitae of the nominee
