Global status of multi-hazard early warning systems: Target G

(UN and WMO; Oct 2022)

This [United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction](#) (UNDRR) and [World Meteorological Organization](#) (WMO) joint report assesses the current global status of **multi-hazard early warning systems** (MHEWS) comparing data officially reported by the Member States with data collected through a WMO survey. The findings identify **countries' challenges** and note **good practices** in **forecasting** capabilities, **early warning coverage**, and **systems to act** on them. The report offers a substantive basis to inform actions in response to the UN Secretary-General's call for '**early warnings for all**', while making policy recommendations for the Mid-Term Review of the Sendai Framework.
