7th Global Summit of GADRI

(21-23 July 2025; Colorado State University, Fort Collins, USA)



The **7th Global Summit of the Global Alliance of Disaster Research Institutes (GADRI)**, hosted by Colorado State University, centers on integrating disaster research with stakeholder engagement to bolster community resilience. The summit, a collaboration with Kyoto University's Disaster Prevention Research Institute, aims to bridge the significant gap between resilience science and its policy implementation. Discussions will focus on aligning with the UNDRR Sendai Framework and the UNCC Paris Agreement, emphasizing gender and youth equity, and the role of science in supporting intergenerational risk equity. The event seeks to improve practical decision-making by involving stakeholders early and addressing the socioeconomic challenges in implementing optimal solutions.
